#### Parish Membership

Active members of our parish are identified by their generosity of time, talent and treasure. Stewardship at is determined by:

- 1.) Being registered for at least 3 months (required of everyone who is at least 18 years of age) and the weekly participation in worship, unless ill or homebound.
- 2.) An identifiable financial support of the Parish. Please use the parish envelope system or OSV Online Giving. If you do not have the means to make a financial contribution, please place an empty envelope in the offertory basket so your attendance at the weekend Mass can be counted.
- 3.) Involvement in at least a ministry, a program, an activity or an organization in the parish.

These criteria listed above are used to appraise or verify parishioner status for sponsorship, parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, pastoral and social ministries, activities and enrichment programs, and use of facilities and services. Members will be marked "Inactive" after 6 months of inactivity and/or failure to use the envelope system.





TAKE WHAT YOU NEED, LEAVE WHAT YOU CAN!



"As Each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace." i Peter 4:10

# While everything is appreciated, there are some items to avoid...

- Avoid glass jar foods in the heat of summer and cold of winter. They
  will explode in the box. Use your judgment with the weather on items
  you place in the box.
- Avoid keeping food in your box that has reached its expiration
  date. While some food is still good after the expiration date, use your
  judgement. We want to give the best quality food possible.
- Avoid putting razors or grooming shears in the box. Children may go to your box so it's better to error on the side of caution.
- Avoid clothing. Your box may become a place others think is okay to donate old clothing, furniture, or household goods. There are other donation services like the Salvation Army or Goodwill that are better equipped to handle those items.
- Avoid medications. As with razors or grooming shears, never put
  medication in the box. Even over-the-counter medications could be
  taken incorrectly, especially by children or those with allergies. Let's
  keep everyone safe by avoiding medications.

# Examples of donations include

- · Any Canned Vegetables and fruit
- Any Canned meat; tuna, salmon, potted meat, etc.
- Chili, Ravioli, Soup, Manwich, Pasta Sauces, Beans, Lentils
- Boxed meals; macaroni and cheese or hamburger helper
- Bottled water, Gatorade, etc.
- Baby food, baby cereal, formula
- Peanut butter or Nutella
- · Oatmeal, Cream of Wheat, Breakfast bars, Grits
- Snacks such as crackers, fruit cups, beef jerky, nuts and seeds




A deacon is an ordained minister of the Catholic Church. There are three groups, or orders, of ordained ministers in the Church: bishops, priests, and deacons.

Deacons are ordained for a ministry of service, which they carry out under the authority of the Bishop. All ordained ministers in the Church are called to functions of Word, Altar, and Charity.

THE DIACONATE IS A VOCATION OF LIFE-LONG SERVICE OF WORD, LITURGY AND CHARITY. THE DEACON IS TO EXTEND THE SACRA-MENTAL PRESENCE OF CHRIST'S SERVICE OUTSIDE OF THE CHURCH AND INTO THE SECULAR WORLD.

Proclaim the Gospel and Preach • Teach the Catholic Faith • Evangelize Believers and Unbelievers

#### THE ALTAR

Assist Bishops and Priests at the Liturgy • Ordinary Minister of Holy Communion • Administer the Sacraments of Baptism and Marriage, Preside at Wake Services and Rites of Burial • Preside at Devotional Services

#### CHARITY

Perform Charitable, Administrative, and Social Welfare Duties . Visit the Sick, Feed the Hungry • Minister to the Imprisoned • Minister to the Bereaved

- New classes form every two years

- Catholic men must be aged 35-60 at time of application to be eligible to apply


