The fourth Sunday of Advent marks the final week of preparation before Christmas, celebrating God's faithfulness in sending Jesus. This Sunday often associated with the candle of love on the Advent wreath, symbolizing the ultimate gift of love that Jesus represents. The readings for this Sunday emphasize themes of love, mercy, and the fulfillment of God's promise through the birth of Christ.

Parish Membership

Active members of our parish are identified by their generosity of time, talent and treasure. Stewardship is determined by:

1.) Being registered for at least 3 months (required of everyone who is at least 18 years of age) and the weekly participation in worship, unless ill or homebound.

2.) An identifiable financial support of the Parish. Please use the parish envelope system or OSV Online Giving. If you do not have the means to make a financial contribution, please place an empty envelope in the offertory basket so your attendance at the weekend Mass can be counted.

3.) Involvement in at least a ministry, a program, an activity or an organization in the parish.

These criteria listed above are used to appraise or verify parishioner status for sponsorship, parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, pastoral and social ministries, activities and enrichment programs, and use of facilities and services. Members will be marked "Inactive" after 6 months of inactivity and/or failure to use the envelope system or OSV Online Giving.



ANOINTING OF THE SICK

If you or a family member become homebound or anticipate entering the hospital for major surgery or a prolonged illness, please notify the church office as soon as possible so that the anointing of the sick may be arranged before entering the hospital. The anointing may take place after Mass or in the church office.



Please do not wait until the situation becomes dire before calling for the Sacrament.

Once the soul has left the body, it is too late. If you have already been admitted to the hospital, please alert the hospital nurse or Chaplin that you are Catholic and in need of a priest. They will be able to contact the priest on the schedule assigned to that hospital and often much faster than attempting to track down a priest after hours. Also, remember according to Church Law, the Sacrament is not to be administered multiple times. Once you or your loved one has been anointed for a specific condition, that is all that is required for one's soul.



- **Legacy:** John is celebrated for his unwavering faith and his role in spreading the message of Jesus. His teachings continue to inspire many today.




